Program Services

Trauma informed care services are individualized services that focus on strengths, needs, and Faith.

- Personal Goal Setting
- Advocacy
- Court approved Prostitution Intervention: **No Charge*
 - a. Theft Prevention
 - b. Community Health Course:
 - i. Aids awareness
 - ii. Free STD testing
 - c. Community Service
 - d. Personal Safety Planning

Program Benefits

- Reduces overcrowding of jails.
- Aids probation in providing new, alternative treatment solutions and support.
- Effective treatment reduces recidivism not previously addressed.
- Lowers tax payer dollars spent on incarceration.
- Stops the spread of STD's
- Promotes community health
- Early identification
- Prompt placement for those who are eligible.
- Prevention of human trafficking
- Lowers risk of victimization and episodes of domestic violence due to education and specialized services.

Requirements: All non-felony prostitution charges. No previous history, arrests, charges, or convictions of violent crimes in Texas or any other State.
